I do hereby certify that Soloman Shipherd enlisted a soldier in the 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia regiment, the latter end of the year 1775, or the begining of the year 1776, and that he served two years (the time for which he engaged) to the northward; and then to the end of the war to the southward in the army of the United States, in the war of the revolution, that he was reputed to be a faithful soldier.
