Thease are to Certify that James Simpkins formly a soldier in the 16 virginia Regment has duly and [undeciphered word] servd the terms of three years for which he Inlisted In Consequence of which and at his own Request he is herby Discharged from any further service in the army of the united states and permted to Return to his home free and unmolisted he haveing Reced all his Bounty pay & Clothing and Depecation of pay Clothing in full of all allowances and Provisions made by Congress to There Troops his Recpt for which is on the Back hereof given under my Pheledlphie 17 Feby 1784
