At a Court held for Fluvanna County September 5th 1782.

On the motion of Joseph Stevens it appeared as proof to this Court that John Stevens enlisted as a Sergeant in the three years service of the United States and that he died in the s'd Service without having [undeciphered] the Court are of opinion that the s'd Joseph Stevens is the Lawful representative of the s'd John and is entitled to the Land allowed [by] Law for s'd service, which is ordered to be certified.
