State of Virginia/ Norfolk County

At a Court held for the County of Norfolk the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year eighteen hundred [undeciphered]

Jesse Nicholson of this county came into Court and made oath that Charles Stewart formerly of this County [two illegible lines] how much longer he does not know, and he believes was afterward promoted to a Lieutenant, which is ordered to be certified.

The Court doth also certify that William Stewart, Charles Stewart and Alexander Stewart are the only [undeciphered] heirs at law of the said Charles Stewart [several undeciphered words] by my hand and caused the Seal of my Office to be hereto affixed on this Sixteenth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, and in the 41<sup>st</sup> year of the Commonwealth.
