The Bearer Patrick Stewart soldier in the fifth Virg'a Regiment, haveing served the full time for which he was Enlisted for, is hereby discharged from the service

Given under my hand this 2^d day of april 1780 Wm. Woodford, Brig'd G [William Woodford] Copy J. Pendleton Jr.

12th May 1783

Patrick Stewart Enlisted in the seventh Virginia Reg't in Jan'y 1776 for two years and reinlisted in april 1777 for three years agreeable to orders from the comm. of the Reg't and during my continuance with him faithfully discharged the duty of a soldier
