At a Court held for James City County June the 12th 1780 a Certificate fro Colo J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of Solomon Stewart's having served as a Soldier three years in the First Virginia State Regiment, the Term of his enlistment & of his being properly discharged and another Certificate from Sam'1 Griffin[?] a Justice of James City County of the said Stewart having made Oath before him that he never before procured or [undeciphered word] his Right to Land for his said military service was produced read & ordered to be certified & recorded B C Waller CC
