## Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

To the Gov. & Council of Va.

The undersigned respectfully represent that thier Ancestor Lawrence Smith, served as Pay master of the Va. Regiment of artillery commanded by Colo. Thomas Marshall [VAS494], and from the time the said Regiment was raised until the Act of Congress which required Pay masters to be taken from the line.

They refer to said Smith's payroll on file in the Auditor's office, commencing Nov. 30, 1777, and ending in Feby 18, 1780, and also to the certificate of Colo. Marshall herewith filed [not found].

Having served as pay master as long as his services were required by his State and until by the act of the Government he was thrown out of service, he became a Supernumerary, and all Supernumeraries being entitled to bounty, your petitioners [undeciphered word] the allowance of land bounty accordingly.
