I do sertify that William Smith was listed in my regiment the 14 of august 77 for three years only and was taken at Charls town [Charleston SC, 12 May 1780] and returned with the flags [of truce] to Jams town [Jamestown VA, summer 1781] that brought our prisoners about six days before Mr. Charls Jones [Charles Jones] landed thare

Received this 21st day of March, 1803, of Samuel Coleman Deputy Clerk of the Council an Original Order directed to Mr. Meriwether March 15th 1783, signed John Alling [VAS2224], requesting the signature of a copy of his discharge, that Wm. Smith might get out his land warrant for him, also a Copy of a discharge from Edward Carrington [W6635] Lieutenant Colonel of Artillery to William Smith a Serjeant in Capt. Coleman's [Whitehead Coleman BLWt467-300] Company in the Regiment of Artillery Commanded by Colo. Harrison [Charles Harrison VAS1411], dated December 20th 1779, and a Copy of a Certificate from Sam'l. Coleman [Samuel Coleman BLWt469-200] Lt. 1st Reg't. Cont'l. Artillery to William Smith, dated July 25th 1783, being papers on which the said Wm. Smith obtained a Land Warrant July 27th 1783.
