Sneed formely a Soldier in the 16<sup>th</sup> Virginia Redgment has duly and Faithfully served his time of three yeares for which He was Inlisted in Concequince of which and at his Owne Request Is heareby Discharged from any other Service in the army of the United States and permited To return to his home free and Unmolisted he Haveing received all his Bounty pay and Clothing & Deficentys of pay and Clothing in full of all allowance And provision and made by the Congress for the Troopes his receipt for which is on the back hearof
