The deposition of Robert Russell Sen [W5753] aged about Seventy two years, who being first duly sworn deposeth and saith that he was well acquainted with Thomas Snead as a soldier, who enlisted in the Company of Capt John Blair [VAS2518] in the ninth Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment in the Revolutionary War, that the said Thomas Snead march with the ninth Virginia Regiment in which Regiment this deponent also marched: that the said Thomas Snead died in the service, as this deponent beleives in the state of New Jersey.
