I do hereby empower Albert Russell [VAS84] to setle my acco't with the State of Virginia & receive my pay and depreciation of pay for my service as a Soldier in 7th Virginia Regiment. Given this 8th July 1784 A copy Jno White Moses Spencer

I do hereby certify that Moses Spencer enlisted in the 7th Virginia regiment the 8th dec'r 1776 and continued in said regiment until the 8th dec'r 1779 at which time he was legaly discharged. Given under my hand this 10th of dec'r 1784 Albert Russell late Capt Pass'd Ch's Jones Com'r./ 24th Dec'r 1784 A copy Jno White.
