In consequence of Orders from the secretary at war dated the 18 of Aug't 1783 Robert Tate Soldier in the Virg'a Line is furlough'd untill call'd for by proper Authority. Given under my hand the date and place above Wm Johnston Capt. Comd. [William Johnston BLWt1166-300] The above soldier inlisted the 1st Nov'r 1782 and was furlough'd agreable to the above Cert. Samuel Hawes [BLWt1066-450] late Lt. Colo.

For a Valuable Consideration I do Assign to Wm Reynolds the bounty of Land full ballance of Pay with all other allowances that may be given by Congress to the soldiers that served to the end of the war Robert Tate Teste Edw'd Valentine Copy A'w Dunscomb
