I do hereby certify, that Severn Teackle of Accomack county was commissioned a Lieutenant in the 9th Virginia Regiment, in the last of the year 1775, or first of the year 1776, that he was afterwards promoted to the rank of Captain; and that to the best of my knowledge & recollection, he served with reputation to the end of the revolutionary war, in the capacity of Captain, including the time of his captivity, he being taken prisoner at the battle of Germantown [4 Oct 1777]. Given under my hand the 17th day of Decem'r 1807. Jno. Cropper Jr. [John Cropper W3781] formerly

I do hereby certify that Severn Teagle was appointed an Ensign in the 9th V. Reg't. on Continintal Establishment the 5th day of February 1776 that on the 4th Day of July 1776 was promoted to a Lieut. and that on the 5th Day of July 1779 was promoted to the Rank of Capt in the 5th V. Regt in which Capacity he Served until some time after the arrangement of the Virginia Line at Chesterfield which Arrangement took place the 10th Day of Feby 1781. Given under my Hand
