I do hereby certify that William Thurston enlisted in the Virginia Continental line 24th May 1777 for three years, he faithfully served as a Drummer untill 27th December 1781 at which time he was discharged the service. given under my hand at Amherst Courthouse 2^d Aug't 1784 Copy J Brown Lt 1st V. R. Sept 2^d 1784/ Examined and passed-mustered in the 1st V. Reg't for three years, he was a Prisoner when the time of his inlistment expired S. Haws [undeciphered] [Samuel Hawes BLWt1066-450] Copy J. Pendleton I do hereby assign the whole of my claim against the united states to Henry Banks for which I have received a full satisfaction and do request the auditors of accts to settle the same with and grant certificates to him the said Banks or order for which this shall be their rec't
