I hereby Certify That in the year 1778 and a part of the year 1779 Roger Tole Served in my Company of New Levies as a private Soldier raised for the Defence of the frontiers of Pensylvania and Virginia and that he was an Honest Orderly Good Soldier and that he served Out his full Length of Time, and in due order Received his Discharge from the Hon'le Brigadier Gen'l Lach. McIntosh [Lachlan McIntosh] who Command the troops Destined for the western Army

Given Under my hand in Fauquier County this 28 October 1811 Wm Withers [William Withers W18351] Lieut Commandant of the said Comp'y

To all to whoom this may Concern

I hereby Certify that I have made over my whole clame right and title to milletary land due for my services in the war to my son Alexander Tolle. Given under my hand this 1st day of August 1814

On the motion of William Tolle Jr and Alexander Tolle and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from the testimony of William Tolle Sen and John Birch that the said Wm Tolle Jr and Alexander Tolle are the sole legal representatives and heirs of Roger Tolle Decd a Soldier in the revolutionary war the same is ordered to be certified accordingly.
