I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

I do here Certatie [certify] that Jack Major Enlisted whith [with] me the 15<sup>th</sup> February 1777 for three years & served of [how] his enlistment in the Second State Regiment. Given under my hand this for April 1785

We do Certify that William Major is an heir & the Legal representative of John Major deceased. Given under our hands this 4<sup>th</sup> of April 1785

S/ James Quarles S/ John Roane

I do assigned to William Bigger a Good Right to John Major pay for his service in the Army S/Wm Major, X his mark 31st March 1785
