THESE are to CERTIFY that the Bearer hereof Joseph Toole in the first Virginia regiment, having fatihfully served the United States from the 20th of March 1780 and being inlisted for the war, is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the war office the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of Feb'y 1784
