Agreeable to a Resolution of Congress bearing date the 26th day of may 1783, the bearer hereof Miles Travis, a Soldier (3 Years) of the first Virginia reg't, has leave of Absence untill Called upon by proper Authority to Join his Corps, or is finally Discharged. Given at Charles Town [Charleston SC] this 2^d of July 1783

Agreeable to a resolution of Congress for Discharging the army The above mentioned Soldier is Discharged from the army of the United States Thos Posey Lt Colo [Thomas Posey BLWt1733-450]
