The Affidavit of Bartholomew Cyrus [W25467] who being first sworn saith that David Turner (son of Mary Turner then of Chesterfield County: now Mary Walker of Bedford County) enlisted in the Year 1777 under Capt James Harris [VAS1448] and after having served three Years in the 15th Virginia Regiment in the Revolutionary War returned home & died some time in the Year 1781 intestate & without issue his mother Mary Walker being his only heir. [Buckingham County, 4 Dec 1818

upon satisfactory proof being made to us Oliver McReynolds & John McAllister two of the Commonwealths Justices of the peace for the county aforesaid. We do hereby cirtify to the Governer and Council that David Turner son of Mary Turner, then of Chesterfield county now Mary Walker of the county of Bedford enlisted for the term of three years under Capt. James Harris of the 15 Virginia Regiment during the Revolutionary War with great Britain, and that the said David Turner served the time for which he enlisted.

Given under our hands this the 18 day of June Anno Dom 1814.
