Entitled to depreciation from 1st Feby 77 to 1st Jan'y 78 if not setled/ Tho. Meriwether

It being for Value Rec'd I do Assign my right & title of the pay due Spen'r Walden from the Country & Land to Jer. Munday, which pay are Justly due him & has never been Setled & my right I do warr't. Aug't the 27, 1787. Jno. Walden Test Jno. Collier I do Assign the ball. of pay & bounty in Land due for the service of Spencer Walden dec'd as afor[esaid] to Wm Reynolds. Jer. Munday Copy Jno Custis
