This day personally appeared before me Samuel Wiles a Justice of the peace for said County William Creekman [William Creekmore (Creekman) VAS1877] who made oath that he knew William Wallace who was a sailor under Capt'n. Willis Wilson [R109] in the war of the revolution and that he continued in service under Capt'n. Wilson the whole of the War. I certify that William Creekman is worthy of credit as a Witness. Witness my hand and seal this 20th day of January 1831.
