Hugh Ward a private in the 1st Virginia reg't formerly of the 8th having served the United States from some time in May 1776 to this date and being enlisted for the War is hereby discharged the American Army. Given the 15th nov'r 1783 A. Kirkpatrick Major [Abraham Kirkpatrick BLWt1210-300] This man was guarding the military stores at new London [present Campbell County VA] when the Troops was discharged [undeciphered] White

pass'd Chas Jones [undeciphered] 22^d Decem'r 1784 (A Coppy) [another undeciphered signature]

Sir please to deliver my certificate and Land warrant to [blank]Hugh his~mark Ward
nov'r 5th 1784

The within Hugh Ward was enlisted for the war and served the time as mentioned in his Discharge James Wood Late B. G. [BLWt2419-500]
