I hereby certify that Lawrence Ward the Bearer was enlisted as a Soldier in the American Service by Leiutenant Crittenden some Time in July 1777, and sworn before me and to the best of my Remembrance his Inlistment was for three years. Given under my Hand this third Day of Aug't. 1780.
