I do hereby Certifie that Wm. Ward a Soldier in Colo. Russells [William Russell BLWt1849-500] Detachment of the Virginia LIne has Served the full term of three years for which he was Inlisted and is now hereby Discharged from the Service—and that he has received his pay in Continental Currency up to the 1<sup>st</sup> of December one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine since which he has only receiv'd two dollars in Specie from the Commisary of Prisoners in Charles Town [Charleston SC] given under my hand at Williamsburg this 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1781
