Lieutenant Henry Waring of 7th Virginia regim't was appointed the 7th of March 1776 & continued in service untill he died: which time I cannot precisely ascertain but from the best information I can collect he died in January 1780 Henry Young Major [BLW2466-300] Lt. H. Waring entitled to depreciation from 1st Jan 77 to 1st January 1780 25th Jan 1785 Charles Jones Com'r a copy Jno White Del[ivered] [undeciphered] White March [undeciphered]

I Hancock Lee Clerk of Essex County Court do hereby certify that William Waring & William Lalane[?] were appointed Executors in the will of Henry Waring dec'd. of the said County that they took upon themselves the burthen thereof & entered into bond for the same. Given under my hand the 22^d day of feb. 1785. Hancock Lee
