I do certify that John Waterfield of the 4th Trop inlisted for the War in Baylors [George Baylor W5966] Dragoons 18th December 1779 (was paid to the 1st reg't & so he continued to serve until the mutiny May 83 [see endnote]

14th December 1783 Wm. Barrett Capt [sic: William Barret VAS1197]

pass'd Ch's Jones Com'r Baylors Dragoons

For value received I do assign to William Reynolds the full ballance of pay & bounty land due me as a soldier from January 77 to the end of the war

Test Eben Macnair John his Xmark Waterfield

14th Dec'r 1784

NOTE: In May 1783 with the war essentially over, cavalrymen in Lt. Col. William Washington's Dragoons in South Carolina grew impatient for transport by sea and rode their horses home without waiting to be discharged.
