Given under my hand Andrew Rodgers [S35635] Lieut. in the 16<sup>th</sup> virginia Rigiment A Buford Colo [Abraham Buford S46372]

At a Court held for Mercer County at Harrodsburg on the twenty fourth day of July 1789
Satisfactory proof was made to the court that William Harskin Watts is Heir at Law to Aaron Watts Deceased which is Ordered to be Certified.
