The bearer hear of Lang Welch a Soldier belonging to the Legion infantry of the State Troops having served During the War with Great Britain, the term for which he was inlisted for is hearby Discharged. we Certify that he has behaved as a brave & faithfull soldier.

Given under my Hand this 22^d Day of April 1783 in the seventh year of the Commonwelth.
