This may certify that Mathew Whirley a Corp'l in the fifth Virg'a Reg't. has serv'd the term for which he was enlisted and is hereby discha'd from the service – that he rec'd his pay up to the first of Decem'r one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine since which he only rec'd two dollars in specie which was sent by Congress to the prisoners at Charles Town [Charleston SC, surrendered on 12 May 1780]. Given under my hand at Williamsburg this 21st July 1781 Wm Johnson Capt Con [William Johnson] I Certifie that Mathew Whorley was in service prior to the 1st Jan'y 1777.
