I do hereby Certify that James White Inlisted in Colo. Charles Harrisons [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery on 21st Dec'r. 1777 and Served in said Reg't til 21st Dec'r 1780 when he received his discharge. William Poythress [VAS262] Nov 22^d 1783 Late Capt Lieut of Artillery the above certificate is Just 24th April 1784 A Bohannan [Ambross Bohannan BLWt280-200]

For Value Receivd I do asign all my pay and bounty of Land to Edw'd. Valentine as witness my hand this 24 day of Aprell 1784 James hisXmark White Test/ George Todd

James White served the three years agreeable to the certificate I countersign'd, he reenlisted in the s'd Regim't some time in 81 for the war. I find in last musters of the Regim't. he deserted the 9th of Feb'y 1783 A Bohannan Richm'd. April 26th 84
