James White Came before me and made Oath that he served in Colo Lee's Legionary troops as a Corporal for Eighteen months and that he never drew any Certificate for the same and also the said White made Oath at the same Time that he has never Received any Warrants of his Proportion of Land for his said service. Given under my hand this 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1787 Charles Chilton
