Halifax County To Wit

This day came Elizabeth Buntin and made oath before me James Warrin a Justice of the Peace in said County, that John Whitlow the former Husband of said Elizabeth, did in the revolutionary war enlist as a Soldier for three years during which time he Died, and that she the said Elizabeth hath not received any Compensation for his services

Given under my hand this 26<sup>th</sup> day of Cotober 1811 James Warrin

Halifax County To Wit This day Came John Logan Before me & made oath, that John Whitlow Did Enlist under a Capt William pointer [William Pointer VAS4143] In the Revolutionary war as a soldier for Three years, during which time he died

Given under my hand this 28<sup>th</sup> day of Oct'r 1811 Charles T. Harris
