I do certify that James Wilkins was a Soldier of my Company of Artillery & was taken prisoner the 16th day of Aug't 1780 [Battle of Camden SC] & I was informed that he died in Jail in Charleston the said soldier was enlisted some time in Dec'r 1777 or January 1778
