At a Court held for James City County June the 12th 1780 a Certificate from Colo. William Brent [VAS2639] of Thomas Williams's having served three years as a Soldier in the Second State Regiment the Term of his Enlistment, And another Certificate from Sam[?] Griffin a Justice of James City County of the said Williams's having made Oath before him, that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said Military Service were produced read & ordered to be certified & recorded Ben C Waller CC
