The Bearer hereof William Williams a soldier of the Virginia State Troops haveing served dureing the war; the term of his enlistment, is hereby discharged, in which we certify that he has behaved as a brave & faithfull soldier Given at Richmond

25 June 1783 Ab. Crump Capt. [Abner Crump R13459] Va Troops

From 20th March 1778 to 31 Oct'r 1781 Ab. Crump Capt 19 Dec'r 1785

The above Soldier has just returned from the so[?; southern?] Army

Capt. Parker near the Bridge [?] Pendleton £1.18.6 due

Capt Bernard comp'y of State Regiment A Jones

The bearer Allen Jones is authorized for me and by me to apply for a certificate & receive whatever may be due for the service as a Soldier I render'd my Country in the late Warr 28 April 1785
