Allison [John Allison W4112] of Zebediah Williams's haveing served three years as a Soldier in the first State Regiment the Term of his Enlistment, And another Certificate from James McClung a Justice of York County, of the said Williams's having made Oath before him, that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said military service, were produced Read & ordered to be certified & recorded.
