I do Certify that John Williamson A Soldier of the 14th Virginia Reg't Inlisted the first day of April 1777 for the term of three years which time he Served faithfully and was discharged the first April 1780 Given under my hand this 10th day Dec'r 1797 Rich. Prince Edward County Sc.

This day Thomas Williamson came before me one of the Common Wealths Justices for the County aforesaid & made Oath, that John Williamson enlisted in the Continental Army in the Virginia line sometime in the year 1777 for three years & that he has reason to believe that the said John Williamson served his time faithfully. Given under my hand this twentyeth day of March Seven [sic] Hundred & Ninety Eight.
