Minnis Ca't. 1st VR [Calohill Minnis BLWt1507-300] (a Copy) J. Pendleton Jr

These are to certify all whom it may concern, that John Philips is hereby empower'd to settle my discharge for the term which I serv'd in the Army in the 1st Virginia Regiment. Given under my Hand the 11th December 1783.
