I do further C[sic] ertify that Elias Wingate did inlist in tow [sic] or three days after being discharged from the artillery in Colo Lees [Henry Lee] Legion Infantry & served truly & faithfully as such for six months & then was pr.moted [promoted] to that of a Corporal & serv'd as a Corporal untill January Eighty one & then was pr. moted to that of Sergant & served untill the end of April or the begining of may in the same

year & was kild [undeciphered] about that time.

Certifyd by me this 25<sup>th</sup>[?] of November 1787.

I cannot undertake to certify prove document the Military services of Elias Wingate, having no records now in my possession but I recollect very well that a good Soldier of that name was in Harrison's [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery & am satisfied he served at least three years
