I do hereby certifye that John Winphrey a Soldier in Colo. Heaths [William Heth BLWt1064-500] Detachment of the Virg'a Line has served the full time of Three years for which he was Enlisted & is now hereby Discharged from the Service & that he has received his pay in Continental Corrincy up to [undeciphered] day of Decem'r 1779 Since which he has only rece'd two Dollars in Specie from the Commissary of Prisoners in Charles Town.

Given under my hand at Williamsburg This 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1781. Dav'd Stephenson [David Stephenson BLWt2057-400]
