This is to certyify that Moses Wright form[erl]y a Solder in the 6st Virginia Ridgmen't Duly and fathfully served the term of Three years for which was inlisted of which he is hear by Discharged from any further servis in the army of united States and permitted to return to his home free & unmeslesled [unmolested] having received all his Bounty pay Cloathen and Leficunce [deficiency] of pay Clothen in full of all accounts & provisions made by the congress for the the troops his recept for which is on the Back his given under my hand at Philedelpia 31 Day of January 1780 Christian Febiger [VAS675] The above is a Copy from the original Lodged in this Office. Auditors Office Ap'l 16, 178[?]

Gentlemen please to pay to the bearer my wages & Land warr[en]t due me on my discharge & in so doing you will much oblige yours &C.
