a decision of the auditor of Public accounts, refusing to allow a certain claim of the appellant against the Commonwealth for services rendered by the said Jarrett Williams in his lifetime, as an Officer in the Revolutionary War

Appeal from

This day came as well the appellant by his attorney, as the attorney General for the Commonwealth, and it appearing by the evidence on the part of the appellant filed in this cause, that the said Jarrett Williams was a Lieutenant in the Illinois regiment in the Virginia line, commanded by Colo. George R. Clark [George Rogers Clark VAS269], in the revolutionary war, and continued to serve as such till the end of the war; That he was entitled to five years full pay, with interest thereon from the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April 1783, till payment, and that the auditor of public accounts erred in rejecting the claim thereto presented by the appellant. It is therefore ordered that the said Auditor do issue and deliver to the appellant, a warrant on the Treasury for the said five years full pay, with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of six per centum per annum from the said 22<sup>d</sup> day of April 1783 till payment; deducting from the amount the sum received by the appellant from the Treasury of the United States, under an act of Congress passed in July 1832.
