I do hereby Certify that Captain Mayo Carrington was an Assistant Deputy Quarter Master General to the Virginia Line on Continental establishment on the tenth day December one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine and acted in that Capacity till the twenty seventh day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty one and that he likewise acted as Quarter Master to General Woodfords [William Woodford's] Brigade from the sixteenth day of July to the tenth day of December one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine being appointed by Gen. Woodford for that

purpose.
