Pension application of Jasper Row VAS72 Transcribed by Will Graves SLV3VA 8/7/12

[From rejected pension records in the Library of Virginia]

I Alexander C. Shackelford being now in my seventy fourth year of age do certify that I was well acquainted with Jasper Row – who did enlist (as well as I recollect as Sergeant) in Captain Boswell's Company in the revolutionary war of the second state Regiment commanded by Colonel William Brent and that the said Jasper Row served three years in succession and was honorably discharged to the best of my recollection. As witness my hand and seal this 14 day of July 1832

I certify that a certificate issued on the 28th of December 1784 to Jasper Rowe a Quarter Master Sergeant in the State line of the Revolution for £43.17.0 being for the balance of his full pay or depreciation agreeably to the act of November 1781 – which said certificate was delivered to Matt Anderson.
