Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

At a court held for Sussex County the 20th day of December 1787

Ordered that it be certified to his excellency the Governor That Susanna Roland [sic] is the widow of Burwell Roland a Soldier in the 15th Virginia Regiment (and that she was formerly on the pension list and by an omission in the Court was left out in the last recommendation of pensioners). That she is now an inhabitant of this County about thirty-five years old hath three children with her and that she is in necessitous circumstances

Sussex County, to wit June Court 1789

Was presented into Court the Governor's Certificate certifying that Susanna Rowland is allowed the Sum of eight pounds per year from January the 1st 1786 to January the 1st 1789 a company with a Certificate from under the hands of a justice of the peace as the law directs. Is therefore ordered that the Sheriff of this County paid her the sum of Twenty-four pounds for the said 3 years pay up to January 1789.
