I do Certify that I inlisted Evan Owens Owens ye 16th May 1778 to Serve three years in ye 3^d. Regiment of Light Dragoons & he was kild at [illegible in online image; see endnote] Surprise of this said Redgm't at Tappan ye same year

Fran's. Dade [Francis Dade] Capt. s'd Regm't

The above mentiond Soldier was Kild the 28 Sep'r. 1778
