NOTES:

According to E. M. Sanchez-Saavedra (*A Guide to Virginia Military Organizations in the American Revolution*, 1774-1787 (Westminster MD: Heritage Books, 2007), the 1st and 2nd infantry battalions (regiments) were raised for state (provincial) defense by order of the Third Virginia Convention at Richmond on 17 July 1775. The officers in the first 15 companies of the two regiments are listed in the first table. On 13 February 1776 the two regiments were brought under Continental Establishment in order to help satisfy Virginia's quota of six battalions for the Continental Army. Officers added to the two regiments afterwards received commissions from Congress and are listed in the second table. Additional details may be found in pension and bounty-land applications.
