I do certify upon honor that the preceding acc't. of the distribution of One Million of State Dollars in August 1781, is agreeable to the receipts given by the Officers & Soldiers at the time of the Payments made — [signed] Sam. Finley Maj'r

March 13th 1784

At the time I marched to joyn the Southern Army in February 1782, I lodged the receipt book, for the foregoing accounts with the Pay Master for the Virgina Line in expectation of his setling, in my behalf, with the board of Auditors for the disbursment of the money When I returned to Virginia I found nothing had been done in the matter, and am informed that most of the Soldiers have setled their acc'ts. with the State, without attending to what money they rec'd. of me – many of the Officers, it may be, have likewise, for want of recollection, & of the charges being produced against them omitted accounting with the State for what they may be here charged with. Now Sir, as I am accountable for the money, and there is no setling with the State for it, I beg you will receive the Acc't. as here rendered into your Office and by

Dr. Sir, much Oblige/ Your very Humble Serv't./ Sam. Finley/ Richmond March 13th 1784 Andrew Dunscomb Esq'r./ Commis'r for Liquidating the/ public acc'ts. with the Virg Line

making a Continental Charge of it, oblige suit as cannot produce a certificate for having already setled

NOTES:

The heading for the first column is partly hidden by an indexing card, and the heading of the next column is entirely hidden.

In the original the surname is usually followed by the middle initial, if any, then the given name. I have reversed the order here to facilitate searching. Alternative name spellings and pension or bountyland applications are given in brackets. The original was arranged with two parallel sets (six columns) per page.
