The Petition of sundry of the Militia (being a majority) in the Company lately commanded by Capt. John Mitchell to the worshipful Court of Brunswick County Sheweth that whereas Mr. William Stith Jun'r. has been appointed to the command of this Company without our knowledge or consent, and the said William Stith at a meeting on Saturday last being willing to decline his appointment, the company made choice of Mr. William Collier as Captian Mr. Zebulon Lewis first Lieutenant Mr. Ephraim Parham second Lieutenant & Mr. Peter Hawthorn as Ensign.. We therefore desire that those Gent'n. may be recommended by the Court for Officers in the Company agreeable to our choice. And your Petitioners

shall ever pray &c. James Ogburn Enlisted after Officers were chosen
