## Southern Campaigns American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Pay-Roll of Captain John Bryce's Company in the 4<sup>th</sup> Continental Artillery Regiment in Georgia 2 April 1782

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

[The 4<sup>th</sup> Artillery Regiment whose troops were mainly from Pennsylvania were attached to Gen. Anthony Wayne in the Virginia Campaign leading up to the siege at Yorktown. Those whose enlistments did not expire continued with Wayne to Georgia, crossing Savannah River on 12 January 1782 to begin driving the British from their outposts into the city of Savannah. After the British evacuated that city on 11 July 1782, the regiment joined Gen. Nathanael Greene in the siege of Charleston SC and were present when the British evacuated on 14 Dec 1782. At the time the payroll below was made out Wayne's forces were still driving the British into Savannah leading up to the siege of that city. The heading of the payroll indicates that it was written at what appears to be "Tenbley Hill," which was presumably in Georgia, but which I have not been able to identify. In the original payroll there are three blank columns not transcribed here, with the following headings: Subsistance pr month – Doll's n's [90ths of a dollar]/ Subsistance for three months – Doll's n's/ Total Pay and Subsistance for three months – Doll's n's. A matross was an artillery Private. Alternative spellings and numbers of pension applications are added in brackets.]
